

Tree Cutting Permit Application Notification and Consent of Neighbours (Owners of property)

When making an application for tree work on District property, the applicant must distribute a consent form to all properties near the proposed work. Neighbours (Owners) adjacent to the subject trees (including across any street, lane or Municipal Right-of-Way) must be informed, by the applicant, of work herein described and signatures must be obtained to this effect.

- Low impact consent requirements include the distribution of the consent form by the applicant to the properties within a 30 meter radius of the proposed work.
- **Moderate impact** consent requirements include the distribution of the consent form by the applicant to all the neighbours within a 50-meter radius of the proposed work.
- **High impact** consent requirements include the distribution of the consent form by the applicant to all neighbours or up to a 150-metre radius of the proposed work.
