	-that by decreasing the combined side yard setback the house would impact privacy to the neighbour	-the East side-yard was increased so that it conforms to DoWV bylaws. This provides further privacy for the neighbour to the East
	-concern of overlook to the immediate neighbour to the Southeast	-exterior louvers were added to the window on the North elevation to provide privacy and windows at the upper floor were pulled back to create additional separation across the side yard

PARKING	that no off-street parking would be provided	-a 2 car garage has been provided
